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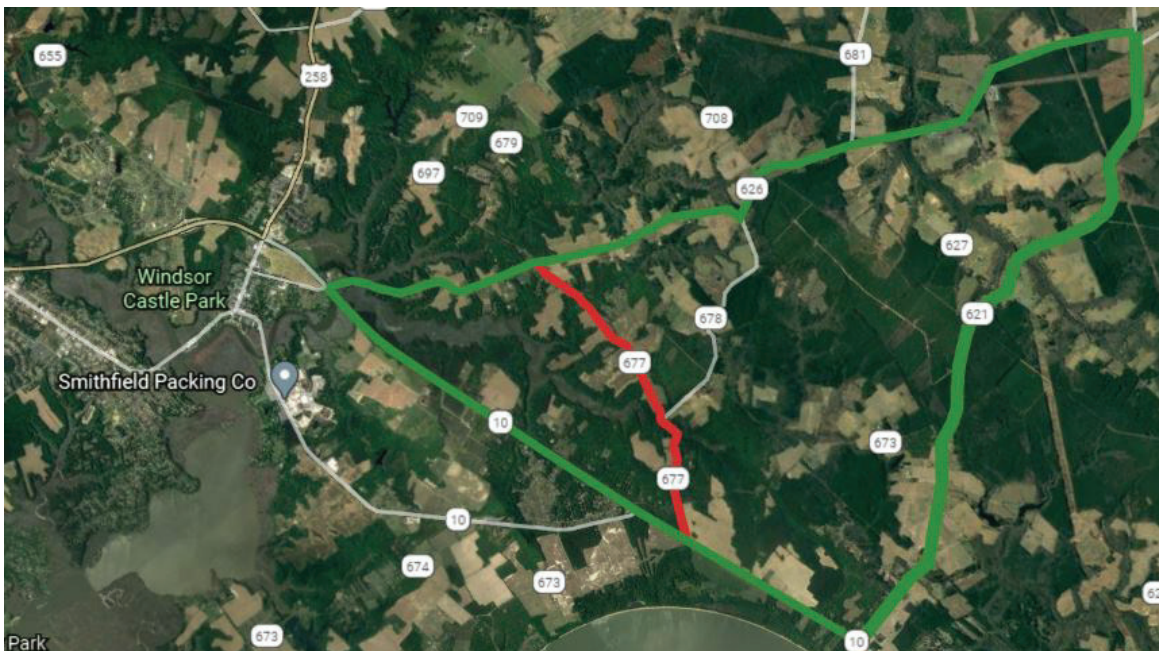
ROUTE 677 TO CLOSE AS BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT BEGINS *Closure with signed detour in place to begin as early as March 15*

ISLE OF WIGHT COUNTY – A Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) project to replace the Route 677 (Wrenns Mill Road) bridge over the Wrenns Mill Spillway is estimated to begin next week. Starting as early as March 15, Route 677 (Wrenns Mill Road) will be closed in both directions between Route 10 (Old Stage Highway) and Route 626 (Mill Swamp Road).

During this closure, the existing bridge on Route 677 (Wrenns Mill Road) will be replaced with a fixed span structure and guardrail improvements will be made. Signed detours are in place and will be directing travel.

The bridge replacement project is estimated to be complete in spring 2021. All construction work is dependent upon weather conditions.
